## The EU's relations with multilateral institutions

### Introduction

This chapter reviews the existing scholarship on the European Union (EU) in international organizations (IO)<sup>1</sup>, with a particular focus on the socio-economic institutions: World Trade Organization (WTO), International Labour Organization (ILO), Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD), International Monetary Fund (IMF), and World Bank (WB). The institutions addressed in this chapter all cover socio-economic topics, ranging from social affairs to development cooperation, trade policy, and monetary issues. Moreover, what characterizes these institutions is that it is the European Commission and not the European External Action Service (EEAS) that calls the tune. Unlike the United Nations (UN) institutions that have received most attention within the literature on the EU and multilateral institutions, they are based not in New York but in Geneva, Paris, and Washington. However, as will be shown later, the EU's membership status in
